- Chief LeMonds attended an online meeting with Systems Design West, the Cowlitz 911 Board Meeting, an online meeting with Chief Goldstein and Tom Maloney (President of the Washington State Association of Fire Marshals), and the Chief and EMS monthly meetings.
- Chief LeMonds sat in on the Cowlitz 911 entrance conference with the State Auditor
- The District responded to a mutual aid call in Kalama for a brush fire where TE62 was hired by DNR for 6 hours
- On August 23rd, the District held interviews and testing for a FF/EMT eligibility list with 12 candidates
- The area behind the station was cleaned up with the parking logs moved towards the building allotting for more space
- There have been two paramedic applicants
- The new ambulance is ready to be placed in service once the state licensing certificate is received
